# Equipment Sub Committee Report 3/12/25

1. All of our corded equipment except for a couple of late donations were tested and tagged. Good news is that all of our equipment passed the electrical testing despite it being some time since last test. It is recommended that this test be carried out each 12 months
2. One combination belt and disc sander was reported operating noisily. Investigated. Bearings replaced and reassembled, seems ok now.
3. We have been donated a Bench-top thicknesser, similar to our Carbatec model. Preliminary testing shows it works very well and cuts cleanly.
4. Wood turning area has been expanded taking advantage of the blocking of the middle door to Machine Room. A safety screen has been added to protect nearby bench from flying debris. It is expected that sharpening facilities will be incorporated between the two lathes.
5. Arrangements to be made for technician from Rone Machine services to attend in the new year for a machinery checkup.
